PAL is a group of local artists and patrons who are dedicated to making the visual arts an integral part of the fabric of life in the Tri-Valley Area. Members include artists of all skill levels, beginners,

hobbiests, and professional artists. PAL features:

**Monthly Meetings** with demonstrations and discussions by established art professionals. These general meetings, held monthly with the Livermore Art Association, alternate between Pleasanton and Livermore. Locations are announced in the monthly newsletter, the Portfolio.

**PAL Annual Art Show**, held in Spring, is professionally judged with ribbons and monetary awards. A PAL Members Show is held each September at the Firehouse Arts Center. The Museum on Main and other shows will be announced in the Portfolio.

**Public Art Circuit:** PAL members are eligible to display artwork in local businesses scheduled by the Circuit Chairperson.

**Art Workshops** are lead by nationally known professional artists and instructors.

**Portfolio Newsletter:** Mailed or emailed to all members monthly. The Portfolio covers local art news, classes and workshops, members' news, exhibits, display opportunities, etc.

Artists' Flea Market: Every Spring PAL sponsors an Artists' Flea Market of art and craft supplies, equipment, bargain art, etc. It is a great place to buy frames, books, paints and items to get started on new projects.

PAL Wall at the Firehouse Arts Center: PAL members' artwork are displayed on the Nancy Thompson Memorial Wall.
